Steps to set up an A&A Account


Go to the Iowa Department of Education Portal Home page - https://portal.ed.iowa.gov. While you are here, please bookmark (add to Favorites) this page. You will sign into the EdPortal from this page.

Step 1: Create An Account



To create an account, highlight "A&A Account" and then click on "Create Account."

The following page will display.




Enter your first name and last name and click "Register."

SSO (Single Sign On) Registration

The SSO Registration page consists of Account ID, First Name, Last Name, and Email. (See example below.)

- You will only need one A&A account, even if you need access to multiple Education Portal applications or need access for more than one organization. (How to do this will be addressed within additional Education Portal Training).
- The Account ID name is for individual use, not groups. No sharing of logins or passwords!
- A&A will create an Account ID with the tag of @IOWAID at the end. You should enter the entire Account ID
 (including the "@IOWAID" suffix) when logging in.
- The Account ID is not case-sensitive: "MYNAME@IOWAID" is the same as "myname@iowaid".
- Spaces and most special characters are not allowed. All invalid characters and spaces will be stripped from the Account ID. Special characters allowed are: _(underscore)-(hyphen)+(plus).(period).



If you get an error message that says "Sorry, that Account ID already exists", someone else with the same name has already created an account. You will need to modify the 'firstname.lastname' format. Try adding a middle inital, a number, or removing the period between names. For example, there can only be one 'mary.smith@iowaid' account.

Once you have checked the information for accuracy, click "Save Account Details". A message box like below will appear stating you are creating a new account. Press "OK" to continue. The account ID will be your login ID for all A&A applications.




IMPORTANT NOTES -

- A&A logins are specific to an individual and should **not** be 'shared' or 'group' logins. In accordance with State security requirements, access to applications and the permissions granted therein are bound to an individual, not a collection of users.
- A&A logins should be associated with your work email address only.
- The closer your login name can resemble your actual name will aid in the identification and permissions process.
- For those of you with an @iowa.gov email address, you will use that for your sign-in for the A&A system.

Tips:

- An email address can only be used once and should be your work related email.
- Do not use special characters (@,#,%,!, etc.) in Account ID or Email

Step 2: Confirm your newly created account




Once the Account Details are successfully saved you will receive an email with instructions on how to activate and use the account.

- · Do not share this email or its contents with others!
- Once you begin the account activation process, you must complete all the remaining steps immediately, which include creating your identity baseline and setting up your password.

Step 3: Create your Identity Baseline

Clicking the link in the email opens this page:




- Choose two baseline questions and then make your own 3rd question and enter answers for each. (These are security questions you can answer later if you ever forget your password.)
- Remember the answers to your Identity Baseline questions; you will use this information to manage your A&A
 account.

Once you have selected and provided your answers click on 'Save Identity Baseline'.

Step 4: Set up Your Password

Next you will be directed to create your password for the A&A system. You will see a screen like the following.


You will set up your password after saving your baseline questions and answers, then log in.



IMPORTANT NOTES - Passwords must have the following:

- must be between 8 and 12 alphanumeric characters.
- must have both upper and lowercase letters.
- must contain at least one special character (e.g. !, @, #, \$, %, ^, &, *, etc.)

Once you have created and retyped your password, click on 'Save New Password'. You will then be directed to the sign-in screen. Type your A&A username and your newly created password and sign into A&A.



• If you will be automatically assigned access to an application (for example, lowa TIER), then **STOP** here - do not proceed until you have been notified that you have application access.

If you proceed with logging in, you will then arrive at the Iowa Education Portal home page. Now what?

• If you need to set up a Portal profile and request applications, then you may do so at this time. Please refer to the next tutorial (lowa Education Portal User Set-up) to help you.

Tips:

- You can make changes later to your name, email, or other details by clicking the "Account Details" button on the A&A sign-in page.
- You can also use the "Forgot Password" and "Forgot ID" tabs on the A&A sign-in page if you need help with accessing your account in the future.

Frequently Asked Questions

What account creation guidance do you have for users?

A&A accounts are specific to an individual and should not be 'shared' or 'group' logins. In accordance with State security requirements, access to applications and the permissions granted therein are bound to an individual, not a collection of users.

A&A accounts should be associated with your work email address only.

The closer your A&A account name can resemble your actual name and your email address, the better.

What can I access?

The Iowa Education Portal currently provides access to many different DE applications, including State ID, ITC, EdInfo applications, EdInsight, and Iowa TIER. Access to these applications will be approved and verified by State Level Security Officers.

Are all browsers and hardware supported?

No. EdPortal is optimized for Firefox, Internet Explorer (10 and below), and Google Chrome on PCs or Macs. We are in the process of adding mobile device support.
